Dear Resident(s):

Please be advised that on October 16, 2017, the City of Simi Valley repealed City of Simi Valley Ordinance 1201 relating to the conduct of registered sex offenders on October 31 (Halloween). This means that Ordinance 1201, which included certain requirements, including placement of a "no candy or treat" sign, turning off lights, not placing Halloween decorations outside, and not answering the door to children, no longer apply and will not be enforced in any way.
