## CORRECTED NOTICE

To Whom It May Concern.

Records indicate that a subject on the National Sex Offender Registry List resides at this address. If you received a letter dated October 1, 2025 in this regard, please disregard that letter and accept this letter as a corrected notice in its place.

This coming Halloween (October 31, 2025), the Hazelwood Police Department will be on patrol conducting home checks to ensure compliance with State and Local law. Halloween-related activities for registered sex offenders are governed under Hazelwood Municipal Code § 215.365 and Missouri Revised Statutes § 589.426. Please be advised that the Hazelwood Police Department will be monitoring for compliance with and/or enforcing the following provisions of law:

- Any person first required to register as a sexual offender under Sections 589.400 to 589.425, RSMo., since 2008, shall be required on October thirty-first (31st) of each year to:
  - Avoid all Halloween-related contact with children: 1.
- Remain inside his or her residence between the hours of 5:00 P.M. and 10:30 P.M. unless 2. required to be elsewhere for just cause, including, but not limited to employment or medical emergencies;
  - Leave all outside residential lighting off during the evening hours after 5:00 P.M.

Any person required to register as a sexual offender under Hazelwood Municipal Code § 215.365 and/or Missouri Revised Statutes §§ 589.400 to 589.425 who fails to adhere to the above compliance violates the provisions of these sections.

Please note that, given pending litigation, the Hazelwood Police Department will not be monitoring for compliance and/or enforcing any provision of law requiring registered sexual offenders to post a sign on their residence stating "No candy or treats at this residence."
